Second, what should you do to *realize your dream?"

Naomi *respects Ms. Chiaki Mukai, the first Japanese woman who went into space. She has a dream of becoming an *astronaut like Ms. Mukai. Takashi has been interested in stars and space since he read Ginga Tetsudo no Yoru, a beautiful story written by Kenji Miyazawa. I've heard from Takashi and Naomi that Kenji Miyazawa studied science hard and wanted to use it to make everyone's life better. I'm also interested in space science because I want to go into space and find new things there to make people happy.

Takashi, Naomi and I tried hard to answer the second question. We thought that three things are very important to realize our dreams. The first thing we should do is to study every subject hard. Everything we learn at school is *useful for working in space. Second, we should learn to *communicate well with other people who have different ideas. In space, astronauts must work together with people from different countries and *make many important decisions. 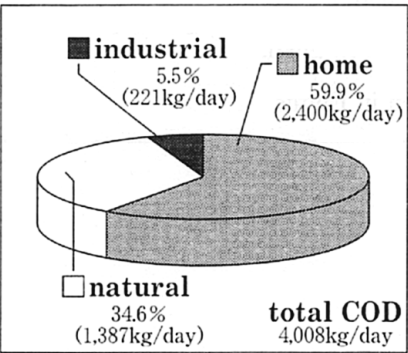
Thank you for your letter. Your report about water pollution was very interesting. I'm also interested in the problem of water pollution. I'd like to tell you about a small lake in my city. The water of the lake was very clean about 30 years ago. There were a lot of fish, and children could swim in the lake. But people stopped swimming there about 20 years ago because it was polluted.

Now, the lake is still polluted and I want to make the lake clean again. But how? One day, I went to the city library and found two graphs. Look at Graph A. We use "COD" to measure the degree of water pollution. A large COD means that there is much pollution in the water. A small COD means that the water is not so polluted. Graph A shows that there are three sources of water pollution in the lake in my city: home, natural, and industrial waste. From this graph, I found (①) waste had the biggest influence of the three on total water pollution in the lake.

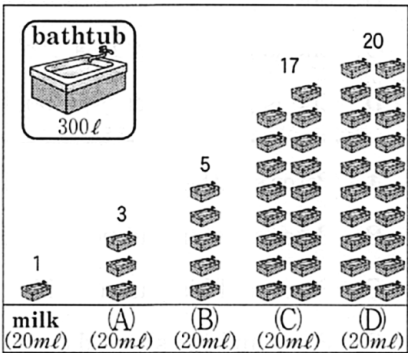
Next, I'd like to tell you about five different wastes: mayonnaise, milk, shampoo, soy sauce, and used cooking oil. They are used and drained in homes every day, so I studied about them. Please look at Graph B. It shows that (②) . 20ml of milk needs 1 bathtub of water to make it clean enough for fish to live in. That's 300ℓ of water. I think that's a lot of water! 20ml of soy sauce needs 3 bathtubs of water. Mayonnaise needs more water than shampoo, and used cooking oil needs the most water of all. Now (③) can we do at home to reduce water pollution? It's not so difficult. For example, we should eat all our food. We should not drain used cooking oil and not use too much shampoo. I decided to write a report about how to reduce water pollution and tell my school friends about it. I hope we can enjoy swimming in the lake some day. What do you think?

Dear Tom,

Hello. We are very happy to hear that you are going to come to our school this winter. Our town is in the east of Hokkaido. People from all over Japan visit our town to enjoy the beautiful nature in every season. We have a lot of snow in winter, but many people come here for this season. Do you know why? Our town is famous for Japanese cranes, tancho in Japanese. We can see a lot of Japanese cranes in our town especially in winter. Today I am going to tell you about Japanese cranes.

Cranes have been symbols of good luck and long life and are loved by the Japanese, but Japanese cranes have a (①) history. Japanese cranes lived all over Japan during the Edo period (1603-1867), but the number of them got smaller during the Meiji period (1868-1912). In 1924, only about ten Japanese cranes were found in Hokkaido.

Why did the number of Japanese cranes become so small? One of the reasons is this: Before the Meiji period, they were in Hokkaido from spring to autumn, but in winter 1. In the Meiji period, 2 because of land development and they had to stay in Hokkaido in winter, so 3.

They had almost nothing to eat, and they didn't eat the food people gave them, so many of them lost their lives.

But in 1950 the people in our town had wonderful news. One morning, some Japanese cranes came to Yamazaki Sadajiro's fields. He put some food there. Then they started to eat the food. They ate the food given by a person!

The people in our town were surprised and felt happy to hear the news. They also wanted to do something for Japanese cranes and began to put some food on their fields. In 1952, counting the number of Japanese cranes was started in Hokkaido and the people in our town helped this activity. In 1957, our school made a club to help Japanese cranes. In 1977, The International Crane Center was built on Mr. Yamazaki's fields. Japanese cranes could eat food in winter there, so they didn't have to worry about it. There were only 33 Japanese cranes in 1952, but the number has become larger: 200 in 1967, 320 in 1982, and more than 1,000 in 2006.

Last winter, some Japanese cranes came to our school grounds. They were so beautiful. We hope that they will come to our school grounds this winter, too. I want to see them with you. It will be very exciting. I hope to see you soon.

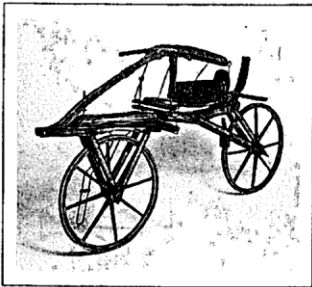

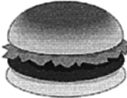

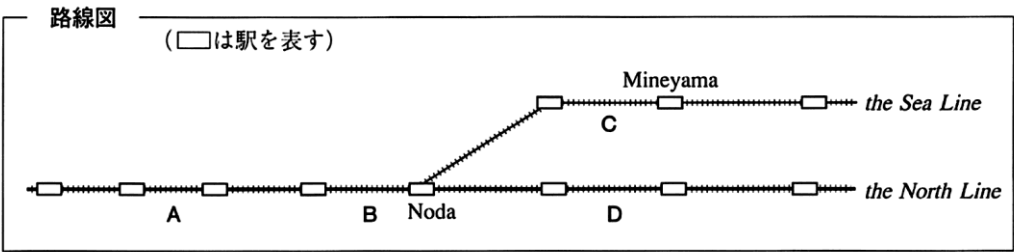
